# ONE HULL SUSTAINABLE COMMUNITY STRATEGY SUMMARY 2009-2011

Hull's Sustainable Community Strategy 2009 – 2011 sets out the vision and priorities partners will work toward in "Creating a Better City" where no one is left behind.

Organisations - under the banner of Hull's Local Strategic Partnership (LSP) ONE HULL - work collectively to achieve these important goals aimed at improving the quality of life of local people.

Public sector agencies like Hull City Council, NHS Hull, Humberside Fire and Rescue Service and Humberside Police have come together to work alongside community and voluntary groups from across the City. Individuals from the business sector also play an important role.

Reducing crime and the fear of crime, securing new jobs, creating a skilled workforce, must go hand-in-hand with other crucial areas of work, such as improving health, tackling teenage pregnancy and smoking, improving attainment at schools, as well as creating further learning opportunities.

The 'Full' Strategy builds on the unprecedented City-wide consultation that took place in 2006 and the recent engagement for Hull's Local Area Agreement (LAA). The LAA is seen as building upon the vision and priorities set out in this Strategy, which recognises that Hull has much to be proud of – but still faces many challenges.



This 'Summary' version gives a brief overview of the issues to be tackled, which alongside the LAA, need to be delivered over the next three years. These include:

**Earning** – working to make sure that all local people thrive economically

**Learning** – guaranteeing that no local child or young person is left behind in achieving their full potential

**Health and Wellbeing** – enabling everyone to make healthy lifestyle choices

**Safe** – helping local people to build strong communities and a City which is a safe place to live

## ONE HULL - EARNING

### IN 2020...

Hull is a sustainable, growing and dynamic economy with more than 20,000 new jobs and 1,500 new businesses created through the growth of the port and related activities, the healthcare sector, developments in renewable energy sector, retail and leisure employment, professional services and construction.

### YOU SAID...

- almost 60% of respondents to the consultation considered the economy to be the most important priority which would help achieve the other priorities.
- economy and better paid jobs means better prospects, more money, more spending and therefore more wealth for Hull.
- higher paid jobs will take many people off the unemployment list.
- if people have money to spend then the economy gets stronger.

### 2011 OBJECTIVES

- Improve the quality of Hull's business infrastructure
- Enhance the competitiveness of Hull's businesses
- Rebuild Hull's entrepreneurial culture and increase the business start up rate
- Encourage employers to invest in higher level skills for their employees
- Create new ways to get into work and learning for Hull's economically inactive residents
- Develop and improve the marketing of Hull as a good place to invest and do business

## ONE HULL - HEALTH AND WELLBEING

### IN 2020...

All Hull citizens live in stronger and healthier communities and health inequalities between different communities within the City are greatly reduced. The increasing diversity of the population is seen as a positive attribute.

More citizens enjoy the benefits of sports, leisure and cultural facilities in the City which have a positive effect on health and wellbeing. Participation in sport is above the England average with professional sporting teams playing an active role in encouraging this in the community.

All Hull children are healthy and active and are provided with the knowledge and skills to make healthy lifestyle choices in the future.

### YOU SAID...

- provide quality, balanced, sustainable housing to meet the needs of all types of people
- promote healthy lifestyle: exercise, stop smoking, healthy food choices
- improve life chances through all residents having an improved quality of life
- empower people to have control over their lives, including their wellbeing
- more playgrounds, sport and places for children to go

### 2011 OBJECTIVES

- To improve the supply of quality housing across all tenures
- To build a balanced housing market and strong communities which contribute to improving health

- To increase participation in physical activity within the communities of Hull that will contribute towards creating a strong local economy which provides an increased chance of employment and generates increased wealth
- To reduce Hull residents' smoking rates and alcohol consumption and improve their weight management, leading to improved mortality rates in relation to circulatory disease, cancer and chronic obstructive pulmonary disease
- To support vulnerable people to maintain independent living by enabling people to address any support needs, in a person centred way, which may impact on their individual ability to live independently

Hull is truly a learning City with participation and attainment in all forms of learning exceeding the UK average. The Early Years' provision ensures that all Hull children start school ready to learn. Learning is delivered in the heart of the community, in schools and in a range of other settings.

- a sound education system will inevitably lead to the other priorities being achieved
- education is essential for the future of Hull
- improved education is needed to provide Hull with a more highly skilled workforce
- education is needed to increase aspirations and expectations

### 2011 OBJECTIVES

- Transform Hull's schools to enable all Hull children to access high quality learning and ensure that all local schools are at the heart of their communities
- Improve literacy and numeracy (for children and adults) to enhance access to opportunity
- Improve participation and achievement in post-16 learning

### IN 2020...

Hull is one of the safest cities in the country, with strong thriving communities, where cultural diversities are valued and celebrated. The City has a strong reputation for embracing diversity.

There is a positive perception of crime reduction in the City, which has helped to create new opportunities for the City's evening economy, as more people seek to spend their leisure time in Hull.

Hull has achieved international acclaim for its local area policing which has had a major impact in reducing a wide range of crimes and anti-social behaviour.

- public safety and a sense of respect must come first, no-one wants to live in a city where crime, violence and public disorder are present
- too many people are afraid to go out of their homes
- other priorities are irrelevant if people are afraid to go out
